Through his understanding of Asian culture, having served the Philippine and Hong Kong brethren for over 20 years, he was the right man for Burma. Mr. Earl served God's people worldwide with a SERVANT's heart for over 50 years.

Even at Mr. Earl's age of 75, he volunteered to travel to our brethren in the small jungle village of JawkTaing, where our pastor Seng Aung and his wife Seng Pan oversee a small growing congregation.

HOW DID WE START A WORK IN A FOREIGN COUNTRY? by Leon Sexton

This is perhaps the biggest mission we have faced. How did we start a Work—meaning the Work of God—in a country like Myanmar (Burma)?

It may be simpler to start a Work in a neighboring country that speaks the same language. But starting a new Work in a country that speaks a foreign language; has a different culture; and a different alphabet—well, we were faced with that dilemma in recent times.

How did we start a Work of God in Burma, a Buddhist country with very few Christians to speak of?

First of all, God must open the door! Then He is our guide and leader Whom we follow.

Burma had a Bible (and a very good one) translated from the original Hebrew and Greek by A. Judson D.D. They had a few missionaries among the hill tribes in former times. Most citizens spoke Burmese, which they learned in school, besides their own hilltribe languages.

In 2001-2, we had already started the Legacy Foundation School in Thailand.

My education was in the Thai culture. I can speak and read Thai well enough.

We originally wanted Thai students to come here. But, as it was, we had mainly hill tribes who spoke their own hill tribe language and their school language which was either Thai, but mostly Burmese.

Amazingly, hill tribes and refugees came from Burma, and they were primarily Karen', Kachin, and Chin.

We had so many Burmese-speaking students that were here to learn English, that we decided to translate our Church of God literature from English into Burmese.

It took a while studying at Legacy, but over time LaNuNan and later AhJar Shan became the most proficient in English. AhJar continued with us even after her graduation in 2012. We chose her to translate more of our booklets and recheck our older booklets done by LaNuNan. She did a fine job on over 20 booklets. To this day she continues to translate for us though she has returned Burma.

Then what about the ministry? Right at the time AhJar was graduating from Legacy, her older brother GumSengAung, and his wife JumSengPan, with their young firstborn son, Blessing, arrived to begin their studies. Both had Seventh Day Adventist University education with emphasis in English. This gave them a head start, with both doing very well and graduating in 2014 after intense studies with our Legacy curriculum.

God uses families in His work many times! This family is a Kachin family and comes from NaMawn, Kachinland.

We had no one at that time who could lead our congregation in JawkTaing. Pastor SawHtooSaw had died in the True Faith and left a gap. There was no one to replace him.

It is hard enough sending someone to a foreign country who does not speak the language. English was out of the question, since very few people spoke English in Burma, except some much older people who maintained their English words from the time Burma was under the British rule.

After SengAung graduated I sent this Kachin couple to JawkTaing (a Karen' village) to work as a Ministerial Trainee. I ordained him in 2017, and he continues to teach and preach. We also continue his training in ministerial studies.

In December 2019, SengAung, SengPan and their third baby—a girl named JaIng—went to a Ministerial Trainee Meeting in the Philippines sponsored by the United Church of God.

SengAung holds Sabbath services every Sabbath and all annual Holy Days.

As I write this, he and his wife have started a “Mini-Legacy” school. With their new router the online classes provided by the SDA school and the classes provided by Seng Pan gives them a well-balanced education. The TRUTH of the Bible is taught by Seng Aung to counter any and all false doctrines. All children from the local villages are invited to attend. This includes all Buddhists, Animists, and Christians from many backgrounds. In this way, Seng Aung provides a public service for all.

In addition, SengAung offers a weekly Face Book and Messenger Bible sermon for any who want to hear and learn the Bible. He also posts additional useful links. Many can contact him with questions and answers. In this way, Legacy Institute continues the Work of God we were given a long time ago.

Please pray for new and better ways to conduct the WORK **GOD** has given us to do.

**UPDATE re: ONLINE SCHOOL
IN JAWKTAING**

In Burma the virus is lessening and some travel is beginning. Two of our young ladies, HserNayPaw and KhawnYi, have just arrived from Yangon. They have requested to come and help Seng Pan at the JawkTaing School. A c-v test was required as well as a two-week quarantine.

The school will also become more structured and applications will be completed by both students and workers. A hand-book of rules for signature is also going to be utilized.

Since the lockdowns are easing up, more children are able to come and return home daily. So, the school is expanding! Due to the government schools still being closed, the children from our church members and the local community will now be able to learn English and computers three days a week for each of the two levels (K-grade 3 and 4th -10th grade). They have all been stuck at home with absolutely no schooling which has frustrated the parents due to the lack of education. In the meantime, the kids have helped with the seasonal “Day Labor” of harvesting rice and working in the rubber plantations.

The purchased router is working out very well with the internet connections, and this will get even better when the planned electricity is installed in their village. SengAung and others are clearing the road and working on putting in the posts at this time. We hope this will be a real blessing for all of them! We take for granted our electricity. For them this will be quite a long-awaited luxury.

FIRST THAI BOOKLET!


